Each instructor will be responsible for three fifty-minute lessons per day (two days per week) in the morning to help students develop skills in, and enhance their understanding of, the performing arts. Ideal candidates should have professional training in the relevant fields, as well as experience in teaching, preferably at a secondary school level.

Creative and Modern Dance

• The instructor is responsible for teaching students basic knowledge of modern dance, providing training in the skills and techniques. S/he is also responsible for staging a dance performance, including its choreography, to be performed by the class at the end of the course.

Theatre Exploration

• The instructor is responsible for coaching students in acting and play-writing, to help students develop a more in-depth understanding of theatre art. Students' effort throughout will contribute to their end-of-course drama performance, to be prepared and organized by the instructor.
