Tender submissions should arrive no later than **12:00noon on 11 March 2026**. Late tenders will not be accepted. In case of a black rainstorm warning signal or typhoon signal No. 8 or above is valid for any duration between 9:00a.m. and 12:00noon, the tender closing time will be extended to 12:00noon on the next business day (i.e. except Saturday, Sunday and public holidays). Your tender will remain open for 90 days from the "Closing Date", and you may consider your tender to be unsuccessful if no order is placed with you within these 90 days. You are requested to note that unless Part II of the tender form is completed, the tender will not be considered.

The supplier / bidder, its employees and agents shall not offer any advantage (as defined in the Prevention of Bribery Ordinance, Cap. 201) to the school employees, SMC/IMC members, or any parent or student representative in a committee responsible for considering any matters in relation to this contract. Any such offer by the supplier / bidder or its employees or agent may constitute an offence under the Prevention of Bribery Ordinance and may render the contract null and void.
