Submission of Applications

- 1. All applications must be submitted through our eAdmissions system. The application period will begin at 9:00am on 17 May 2021 and end at 4:00pm on 28 May 2021. Late applications will not be accepted.
- 2. Please note that each applicant can only apply for ONE year level only. Any duplicate application will NOT be processed.
- 3. Applicants have to complete an online application and upload supporting documents through our eAdmissions system. Successful submission of applications will be acknowledged via email.
- 4. Applicants may edit the application any time during the application period. Once the application period is over, no further amendments can be made although applicants may still check system messages and review the submitted materials via the Applicant Portal.
- 5. A non-refundable administration fee of HK\$50 will be levied via the eAdmissions system.

Selection Process

- 1. Selected applicants will be notified in late June and invited to sit a written examination.
- 2. The written examination, covering the relevant general knowledge in Chinese, English and Mathematics, is tentatively scheduled to be held on 10 July 2021.
- 3. Based on the merits of the written examination, further shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview.
- 4. All applicants will be notified of the outcomes of their applications by email in late July.
