St. Paul's Co-educational College Fundraising Annual Report 2018-2019

St. Paul's Co-educational College ("SPCC") is respected for its academic and musical excellence while upholding the Christian spirit and principles. The school is dedicated to preserving the basic elements of traditional Chinese education while incorporating modern educational theories, concepts and values. SPCC is recognised for the valuable contributions its graduates, being leaders in their respective professions, have made to Hong Kong.

Founded by the Sheng Kung Hui in 1915, the school was originally a girls' school. It started to accept both boys and girls — the first in Hong Kong — when it was merged with a boys' school in 1945.

SPCC is one of the first schools to convert from an aided school to a Direct Subsidy Scheme school, and has adopted a 'through-train' mode with its primary school since 2002. The school remains committed to a need-blind admission policy and offers quota-free fee remission and financial aid to the financially disadvantaged to ensure that it will not turn into a school only for those who can afford to pay the tuition.

In 2008, the primary school moved from Central to a new, state-of-the-art campus in Wong Chuk Hang, making way for the construction of an extension block for the secondary school on MacDonnell Road.

The extension block, Li Chong Yuet Ming Building, opened in 2011 and provides a residence hall, a lecture theatre, an indoor games hall, science laboratories, classrooms and other special rooms to advance our facilities to meet future curriculum requirements. The existing red-brick campus has been reconfigured with modernisation of the library, upgrading of sports facilities and expansion of music facilities for a better, holistic education.

2018 至 2019 年度聖保羅男女中學籌款年報

聖保羅男女中學（「聖保羅」）秉承基督教的精神及原則辦學，以學術及音樂上的卓越成就見稱。學校致力保存傳統中國教育的優良元素，同時結合現代教育理論、概念及價值觀。歷屆畢業生於社會各專業領域人才輩出，領導同儕，為香港發展作出貢獻。

本校由聖公會於 1915 年創立，起初為一所女校。於 1945 年與另一所男校合併，成為香港首間兼收男女生的學校。

2002 年，聖保羅成為首批由津貼學校轉為「直接資助計劃」之學校，並與其附屬小學採用升中「一條龍」的模式運作。聖保羅一直堅守「惟才是教」的收生政策，並為有需要的學生提供適切完善的財政資助及學費減免計劃，支援措施均不設名額上限，確保具潛質的學生不會因家庭背景或經濟因素而影響就學。

小學於 2008 年搬離中區，遷至黃竹坑的嶄新校園，騰出麥當勞道原校舍用地，興建中學新翼。

中學新翼「李莊月明樓」於 2011 年落成啟用，提供宿舍、演講廳、體育館、實驗室、課室以及其他特別室，使中學設施更趨完善，以配合未來課程的要求。原有的紅磚校舍亦進行改善工程，強化全方位學習，包括翻新圖書館和體育設施及擴充音樂設施等。

It is our pleasure to enclose the Fundraising Annual Report for St. Paul's Co-educational College for the academic year 2018-2019.

During the year, total cash received by The Council of St. Paul's Co-educational College Charitable Trust (the "Trust") from various fundraising activities including cash donations made to satisfy outstanding pledges was HK\$25.4 million, of which HK\$3.2 million was raised through the Annual Walkathon.

In 2018-2019, the Trust awarded a total grant of HK\$4.97 million to St. Paul's Co-educational College and Primary School, to support e-Learning and e-Library initiatives, additional social work service, staff development programmes, various extra-curricular and student enrichment programmes in the area of music, sports, arts and culture, leadership and experiential learning.

SPCC Charitable Trust

The Council of St. Paul's Co-educational College Charitable Trust ("SPCC Charitable Trust" or the "Trust") was established in January 1999 for the specific purpose of accepting donations in order to give financial support to St. Paul's Co-educational College and its Primary School ("SPCC"). The Trust has obtained Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance Exemption which gives donors the ability to claim tax relief in Hong Kong for donations made to SPCC Charitable Trust. The current Trustees are listed on Page 5.

Since its establishment, SPCC Charitable Trust has made annual grants to SPCC to support a variety of programmes and educational initiatives: e-Learning and e-Library initiatives, Rites of Passage, international conferences, music tours, overseas study trips, professional coaching for sports team training, community service work, leadership training, music and dance training, enrichment programmes and extra-curricular activities, staff development programmes, additional social work service, and to provide financial assistance to needy students in terms of bursaries and scholarships.

The five-year Landmark Fundraising Campaign ended in December 2007 turned out to be a great success and it helped to raise funds for our hardware: the new Primary School campus in Wong Chuk Hang and the redevelopment of the Secondary School campus on MacDonnell Road, providing students with a wonderful learning environment. It was not only a fundraising venture, but it also laid the foundation for a giving culture within the SPCC family. More importantly, it provided a wonderful opportunity to reconnect and revive the incredible bond and strong comradeship that has linked many of our alumni and friends over the years.

The Centenary Fundraising Campaign launched in 2013 with an aim of establishing endowment funds that will generate recurrent income to support its educational goals: to offer the **best students** the **best education** with the **best teaching force**. It ended successfully in August 2016 having raised HK\$212.8 million, enabling SPCC to build a strong professional teaching force, expand and enrich its holistic learning programmes for students, and admit the best students while ensuring financial assistance for the students in need.

It is the Trust's mission to provide staunch and unfailing support to SPCC, for the purpose of improving and enhancing its quality of education, strengthening its position as a world class school and achieving its milestone developments. Continuous support from the community are required for building up a strong endowment in order to provide a steady stream of funding, helping SPCC to achieve its educational goal.

Development Office

SPCC established Development Office in 2002 and subsequently restructured to be part of Community Relations Office. The responsibilities of Development Office are solely focused on fundraising, providing administrative support to SPCC Charitable Trust and handling all enquiries relating to fundraising. 聖保羅慈善信託基金

聖保羅男女中學校董會慈善信託基金（「聖保羅慈善信託基金」或「信託基金」）於 1999 年 1 月成立，特別為接受捐贈予聖保羅男女中學及附屬小學（「聖保羅」）之善款而設。此信託基金為香港稅務條例第 88 條豁免之慈善團體，因此捐款人士可將捐贈予聖保羅慈善信託基金之善款，申請扣稅。信託基金現時的信託人名單詳列在本頁。

信託基金自成立以來，每年均資助多個教育項目，包括電子教學及電子圖書的項目發展、成長體驗營、國際研討營、音樂交流活動、海外遊學團、校隊訓練、社區服務、領袖訓練、音樂及舞蹈培訓、課外活動及增潤課程、老師專業培訓活動，增加駐校社工服務，亦為有需要的學生提供適切的資助，如助學金及獎學金。

為期五年的「新里程籌款運動」於 2007 年 12 月圓滿結束，捐贈款項主要投放於學校的硬件上：包括興建位於黃竹坑的新小學校舍及麥當勞道的中學校舍擴建計劃，為學生提供優越的學習環境。這項創舉除了為學校發展籌集足夠資金外，同時亦在聖保羅這個大家庭中孕育出樂善好施的捐贈文化，並且重燃舊生及友好對學校的關愛。

「建校百周年籌款」於 2013 年開展，為聖保羅的未來成立發展基金，以支持學校的發展及貫徹聖保羅「良育」、「良師」及「良才」的教育理念。2016 年 8 月圓滿結束，成功籌募港幣 2 億 1,280 萬元，用以加強全方位學習課程；建立專業優秀的教師團隊；錄取具潛能的學生以及為有需要的學生提供適切、全面的資助。

信託基金致力實踐其使命，為聖保羅在辦學理念及財政上，給與無限的支持，使學校可以推出多項發展大計，進一步鞏固其頂尖級學府的地位。為建立一個穩健的基金，確保可提供穩定的資金來源，信託基金需要眾人的繼續支持，與聖保羅攜手繼續培育人才，為未來社會發展作出貢獻。

拓展事務部

Programmes and Activities supported by SPCC Charitable Trust



St. Paul's Co-educational College has been serving the community since 1915 by educating talented students from a wide spectrum. The transition from an aided school to a Direct Subsidy Scheme ("DSS") school enables St. Paul's Co-educational College and Primary School ("SPCC" or "School") to have more flexibility in curriculum planning and resource management. To maintain its educational excellence, SPCC requires financial resources to continuously make improvements to its programmes and launch new educational initiatives to adapt to the changing environment.



SPCC offers the curricula of the local Diploma of Secondary Education (DSE) and the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in parallel. The provision of the dual curricula enables the School to better cater to our diverse student body, which encompasses a broad array of talents and interests and different learning styles.



At SPCC, students are provided with the best of education with holistic development on their personal, moral and social attributes. The School further expands on the range of enrichment programmes, local and overseas, that are designed to develop and realise the different potentials of students, particularly, in the four areas: Music, Sports, Arts and Culture, Leadership and Experiential Learning. For Primary School, there are 5 classes in each grade and about 28 students in each class. Key subjects for upper Primary classes are taught in small groups with about 12 students each. For Forms 1 to 3, there are 7 classes in each grade and about 34 students in each class. Students are organised into smaller sets with about 22 students in each set for English, Chinese, Liberal Studies and Mathematics lessons. Smaller classes and smaller subject groups are introduced for Forms 4 to 6, with 9 classes in each grade and about 22 to 24 students in each class. Subject group sizes range from 5 to 26 students. The smaller class and group learning allows for more interaction and personalised learning, helping to instil in students fine learner attributes.



Not only expanding the diversity of learning programmes, SPCC also expands its teaching force and enhancing its calibre. Before joining DSS in 2002, the ratios of students to academic staff for Secondary School and Primary School are around

19:1. In 2019/20, the student-teacher ratio is 9.1:1 in the Secondary School and 7.8:1 in the Primary School. Moreover, the School continues to invest in teachers' training and professional development, in particular, strengthening lesson design and pedagogies in small-class teaching.

The School remains committed to a need-blind admission policy with a quota-free fee remission scheme to ensure that SPCC will not turn into a school only for those who can afford to pay the tuition. Students are admitted by merit and potential regardless of their family or social backgrounds. Bursary and financial aid are readily available to ensure adequate support to the financially disadvantaged, covering their schooling necessities (eg, textbooks, school meals, uniforms and school bus) as well as a range of learning opportunities (eg, overseas exchange and extra-curricular activities).

The aforesaid initiatives will not be possible without adequate funding. It is essential for the Trust to establish endowment funds to provide a steady stream of funding. These include a general endowment and four purpose-specific funds for the four major areas identified for a rich, diverse and holistic education for students: Music, Sports, Arts and Culture, and Leadership and Experiential Learning.

During the academic year 2018-2019, the Trust awarded a total grant of **HK\$4.97 million** to St. Paul's Co-educational College and Primary School, of which **HK\$1.12 million** was granted to: e-Learning and e-Library initiatives including the purchase of tablet devices for students under fee remission scheme. **HK\$2.94 million** to provide scholarships and bursaries, and to support various extra-curricular and student enrichment programmes including: Form 2 cultural trip to Nanjing; Form 3 Rites of Passage; community services work; leadership training programmes at Ma Wan Park, music and dance training; school team training in badminton, basketball, cross-country, fencing, football, swimming, table-tennis and volleyball; Artist-in-Residence programme; Odyssey of the Mind and theatre exploration; International Music Conference; Primary 5 Outward Bound programme; Primary 6 Graduation Camp cum Study Tour; **HK\$0.54 million** to provide additional social work service; **HK\$0.37 million** to support staff development programmes for the continuous improvement of the professional expertise of staff.



聖保羅慈善信託基金資助的 項目及活動



聖保羅男女中學自 1915 年創校至今，一直秉承關心社會的優良傳統，以培育社會各階層具潛質的學生成為卓越優秀人才為己任。自聖保羅男女中學及其附屬小學（「聖保羅」或「學校」）由資助學校模式轉為直接資助（「直資」）學校模式辦學後，學校的課程設計及資源運用更靈活自主。為保持最佳的教學質素，聖保羅必須備有充裕的資源，持續革新課程，引進新教材及教學方式，以適應不斷蛻變的環境。



配合學生不同學習志向，學校開設香港中學文憑 (DSE) 及國際文憑 (IBDP) 雙軌課程，以供學生自由選擇。雙軌課程設計靈活多元，迎合學生不同學習志向及需要，讓他們發揮潛能，盡展才華。



聖保羅致力為學生提供優質的全人教育，著重培育學生個人、品格及社會承擔等優良素質。學校將繼續開拓更多本地及海外的增潤活動，讓學生獲得更多學習機會，尤其在音樂、體育、藝術及文化、領袖訓練及體驗學習等四大範疇的潛能中充分發揮所長。小學每級五班，每班約 28 人。高年級中、英、數設小組教學，每組約 12 人。中一至中三級各有七班，每班約 34 人。中、英、數及通識科以小組教學，每組 22 人。中四至中六級引入小班及小組教學，高中各級分九班，每班約 22 至 24 人，選修科以小組教學，每組 5 至 26 人。小組及小班學習能增強教與學的互動，有助提升教學質素及培育學生個人素養。



除了多元化的學習活動外，聖保羅亦投放更多資源擴大教學團隊，及進一步提高教師專業水平。2002 年加入直資計劃前，中學及小學的教師與學生數目比例約為

1:19。2019/20 年度，中學師生比例上調至 1:9.1，小學至 1:7.8。學校將繼續投放資源於師資培訓及專業發展上，重點強化小組教學的課堂設計及教學方法。

聖保羅一直堅守「惟才是教」的收生政策，並提供不設名額上限的學費減免計劃，照顧不同背景學生的需要，確保具潛質的學生不會因經濟因素而影響就學。取錄按學生的資質及學習潛能而定，從不取決於其家庭背景。聖保羅更設有多項助學計劃，有需要的學生除了可獲資助書簿、校內午膳、校服及學童巴士服務等基本學習開支外，更包括海外交流等各式各樣的課外學習活動，確保有財政困難的學生在聖保羅的學習旅程同樣多姿多彩。

上述教育項目得以落實，有賴充裕的資金支持。聖保羅慈善信託基金需要籌募足夠善款成立基金，為各類教育項目提供穩定的資金來源。發展基金包括「一般基金」及「特別才能基金」。後者專為下列四個主要範疇提供資助：音樂、體育、藝術及文化、領袖訓練及體驗學習，務求讓學生體驗到豐富均衡而多元化的全人教育。

聖保羅慈善信託基金於 2018 至 2019 學年，共撥款港幣 497 萬元予聖保羅男女中學及其附屬小學，其中港幣 112 萬元用以資助電子教學及電子圖書的項目發展，包括為學費減免的學生購置平板電腦。港幣 294 萬元予獎學金及資助多類課外活動及增潤課程，包括中二南京文化之旅、中三成長體驗營、社區服務、馬灣公園領袖訓練營、音樂及舞蹈培訓、羽毛球、籃球、越野、劍擊、足球、游泳、乒乓球及排球等校隊訓練、駐校藝術家計劃、創意思維世界賽、戲劇班、國際音樂交流大會、小五外展訓練課程、小六畢業營暨學術交流之旅。港幣 54 萬元增加駐校社工服務。港幣 37 萬元資助老師的專業培訓活動。

- The Fundraising Committee gave fundraising updates to the parents at the Parent-Teacher Associations Annual General Meetings in October and November 2018, and to the alumni at the Alumni Annual Dinner and Summer Gathering in October 2018 and June 2019 respectively.

The Trust manages its investments following an endowment model with more than 90% of the Trust's assets committed to two Endowment Portfolios whilst maintaining a healthy cash reserve.

For the fiscal year 2018/19, the Endowment Portfolios generated a net return of 2.2%, slightly ahead of its benchmark of 1.4%. The Trust received cash payout from the Portfolios of HK\$4.9 million during the year.

Both stock and bond markets have reversed course and rallied strongly in 2019 after a challenging 2018; however, performance of risk assets over recent months has been increasingly volatile. Persistent sources of risk include trade tensions, geopolitics, financial condition deterioration, and slower economic growth.

For the 2019 fiscal year, public equity edged higher in a more challenging environment that was marked with episodic volatility. For fixed income, Fed's unexpected pivot on policy from raising interest rate to cutting interest rates has contributed to the underperformance in this asset class as active managers anticipated an inflationary climate. The hedge funds asset class continues to provide the portfolio with attractive risk adjusted returns relative to benchmarks.
