- Rank order (35 points)
- Interview (35 points)

- Financially needy students Application criteria
  - Eligible for 100% fee remission
  - Rank top 10 in the whole class level - Grade B or above in conduct - Headteachers' nomination
- 100% fee remission in F.1
  - (annual application)

#### School Nomination Scheme (OS)

- Very outstanding students
- **Application criteria** 
  - Rank 1st in the whole class level
  - Grade B or above in conduct
  - Headteachers' nomination
- Academic entrance scholarship
  - \$2,000

- Achieve national/ regional junior level
- To apply
   complete the relevant section of the online application form and upload supporting documents
   upload Coach Reference Form (optional)

 Grade B or above in conduct
 Shortlisted applicants – interview in mid Dec

 Sports training by coaches



# Scholarships

#### **Scholarship Examination**

- Scholarship Examination after admission
  Academic entrance scholarship for students in top 15%
  - \$4,000 for top 5%
  - \$2,000 for the rest
- Also an allocation test ALL are required to sit for the examination



# Scholarships

#### **Scholarship for Academic Excellence**

subject to review as needed



On promotion to F.2 and up to F.6 – Rank top 15% in the whole class level – Grade B or above in conduct \$2,000 - \$6,000 , depending on class level and

performance



# Scholarships

**Students entitled to 2 academic scholarships** will receive - both in name - the scholarship of the higher value • Academic scholarships & YT Scholarship may be awarded concurrently

# **School fees**

- School Fee (for 2020/21 school year)
  - Local curriculum
    - \$64,500 per annum
  - IB
    - F4 Prep. Yr.: \$64,500 per annum F5 & 6 IBDP: \$96,500 per annum
- Fee remission



## **Financial Aid (1)**

### Objectives

- No students will be denied entry due to financial reasons
- Up to 100% school fees remission & quota free
- Eligible for government SFAA & CSSA recipients



## Financial Aid (2)

Bursaries and subsidy for fee paying student enrichment activities, including R.o.P. & overseas programs

Additional 20% fee remission for single parent families





# **Fee Remission Scheme(1)**

- Basic criteria
  - Based on a 4-person household, the Benchmark Disposable Income (BDI) per annum is \$348,000
  - BDI = Family income after accommodation expense



# **Fee Remission Scheme(2)**

#### • Basic criteria

Also consider the amount of family assets (i.e. excluding the principal family residence and deduct first \$500,000)

Each additional family member increase the BDI by \$116,000





# **Fee Remission Scheme(3)**

Exceed the BDI by	% of school fee remission
\$0-1-1/	100
No more than \$116,000	80
No more than \$232,000	60
<b>No more than \$348,000</b>	40
No more than \$464,000	20
More than \$464,000	nil

 Completed fee remission application form with photocopies of required supporting documentary evidence

- A signed declaration under oath

 - 3 self-addressed and stamped envelopes

## **Fee Remission Application (2)**

- **Application period** 
  - School Nomination Scheme (FN) applicants: 2 Nov to 20 Nov 2020
    Other applicants after admission: April to Mid-May 2021
- Renewal
  - application made annually
- Information kept confidential Fee remission calculator at school website (www.spcc.edu.hk) 23



#### Bursary

• For full fee remission students

 Maximum subsidy per annum \$4,000 meals \$3,000 textbooks\* \$2,000 school uniforms
