- Around 100 places for non-feeder primary school applicants
- Interview
 - ❑ ~ 450 shortlisted applicants
 - ❑ Criteria:
 - information provided/ documents
 - rank order



General Admission

- Admission criteria
 - Conduct (10 points)
 - Academic & non-academic performance (20 points)
 - Interview (35 points)
 - Rank order (35 points)



School Nomination Schemes

- **Students with Financial Needs (FN)**
- **Outstanding Students (OS)**





School Nomination Scheme (FN)

- Students with Financial Needs
- Application criteria
 - Eligible for 100% fee remission
 - Rank top 10 in the whole level
 - Grade B or above in conduct
 - Headteachers' nomination
- 100% fee remission in F.1
(annual application)



School Nomination Scheme (OS)

- Very outstanding students
- Application criteria
 - Rank 1st in the whole level
 - Grade B or above in conduct
 - Headteachers' nomination
- Academic entrance scholarship
 - \$2,000



School Nomination Schemes

- Students with Financial Needs (FN)
- Outstanding Students (OS)

To apply

- specify in application form (Part IV)
- School Nomination Form
(upload scanned copy **AND** return original copy)
- Fee Remission Application Form & supporting documents by hand
[*FN Scheme only*]





School Nomination Schemes

School Nomination Form

- (1) obtain the Primary School Headteacher's consent
- (2) give the School Nomination Form to the Headteacher
(download from system)
- (3) consult the Headteacher how he / she would like to return the form
Method 1 (Applicant to upload AND return form)
Method 2 (Headteacher to upload AND return form)
for Method 2, please ask your Headteacher to provide a school-domain email address for you to enter in the system
- (4) the original copy must be returned to the College by post / by hand before the application deadline





Young Talents (YT) Scheme

- Achieve national/ regional junior level
 - YT Scholarship - \$4,000
 - Renewable yearly
 - Satisfactory performance in the talented area
 - Grade B or above in conduct
 - Shortlisted applicants – interview in mid Dec
-
- Programme for musically gifted
 - Sports training by coaches



Young Talents (YT) Scheme

- To apply
 - specify in application form (Part V)
 - provide relevant and updated supporting documents
 - submit a Coach Reference Form via our eAdmissions system (*for Sports only; optional*)



Scholarship

Scholarship for Academic Excellence

- On promotion to F.2 and up to F.6
- Rank top 15% in the whole level
- Grade B or above in conduct
- \$2,000 - \$6,000 , depending on class level and performance

**Academic scholarships & YT Scholarship may be awarded concurrently*



Procedures & Documents

Submission of Applications:

- complete an online application and upload supporting documents through our eAdmissions system.
- application fee of HK\$75
- Email and HK mobile no. for receiving notification
- Successful submission of applications will be acknowledged via email.
 - During the application period, applicants may **edit anytime**
 - After the application period closed, **no further amendments could be made.**
- Dashboard: check system messages and review application

Deadline: 17 November 2023 by 4:00 p.m.

1. A recent ID photo (*File Format: gif / jpg / png only*)
2. Primary 5 school reports (including results of **ALL** terms and **conduct**) [in 1 file]
3. Information on ECA
(max. 5 items per category; most recent results / highest attained level only)
4. [*Applicants of School Nomination Scheme (OS/FN) only*]
School Nomination Form
5. [*Applicants of School Nomination Scheme (FN) only*]
Fee Remission Application Form & relevant documents (by HAND)
6. [*Applicants of YT Scheme only*] Supporting documents (if applicable)
7. [*Applicants of YT Scheme (Sports) only*] Coach Reference Form (optional)

School fees

- School Fee (for 2023/24 school year and subject to annual revision)
 - F1**
\$72,400 per annum
 - IB**
F5 & 6 IBDP: \$102,000 per annum
- Fee remission



Financial Aid (1)

Objective

- No students will be denied entry due to financial reasons
- Up to 100% school fees remission & quota free
- Eligible for government SFAA & CSSA recipients



Financial Aid (2)

- Bursaries and subsidy for fee paying student enrichment activities, including R.o.P. & overseas programs
- Additional 20% fee remission for single parent families



Fee Remission Scheme

- Basic criteria
 - Based on a 4-person household, the Benchmark Disposable Income (BDI) per annum is \$368,000
 - BDI = Family income after accommodation expense
 - Also consider the amount of family assets (i.e. excluding the principal family residence and deduct first \$500,000)



Fee Remission Scheme

Exceed the BDI by	% of school fee remission
\$0	100
No more than \$122,650	80
No more than \$245,300	60
No more than \$367,950	40
No more than \$490,600	20
More than \$490,600	nil



Fee Remission Scheme

- Application documents required
 - Completed fee remission application forms with photocopies of required supporting documentary evidence
 - A signed declaration under oath
 - 3 self-addressed and stamped envelopes



Fee Remission Scheme

- Fee remission calculator at school website (www.spcc.edu.hk)
- Application period
 - School Nomination Scheme (FN) applicants:
30 Oct to 17 Nov 2023
 - Other applicants after admission:
April to Mid-May 2024
- Renewal
 - application made annually
- Information kept confidential



Bursary

- For full fee remission students
- Maximum subsidy per annum
 - \$4,000 meals
 - \$3,000 textbooks*
 - \$2,000 school uniforms

**To deduct the amount received from Government textbook assistance*



Subsidy for Overseas Enrichment Activities

- E.g. F1 English Enhancement Program - London UK 2023

Items payable by students: \$43,500

For students under the Fee Remission Scheme

School Fee Remission (%)	Subsidy Awarded for Tour	Amount Payable
100	\$43,500	-
80	\$34,800	\$8,700
60	\$26,100	\$17,400
40	\$17,400	\$26,100
20	\$8,700	\$34,800
