Fee Remission

Achievements and Reflection on Major Concern for Future Planning

1. *Staff capacity development in Teaching and Learning, Moral Education and Pastoral Care, Student Development*

Teaching and Learning

Subject departments continued to implement various measures to enhance effectiveness in teaching and learning. Increased efforts were seen among teachers to employ a wide repertoire of teaching strategies including e-learning and experiential learning. Teachers attended courses to upgrade pedagogy and shared good practices through collaborative lesson planning. Teachers from different key learning areas were nominated to attend intensive structured training courses provided by the

Education Bureau to enhance professional capacity in supporting students with special educational needs.

A staff development day was held to strengthen teachers' understanding of positive education. During the school year, members of the Moral Education Team also helped in promoting the use of positive education among subject departments.

Moral cum Civic Education and Pastoral Care

The Moral cum Civic Education and Pastoral Care Team continued to actively help teachers build their confidence and competence in providing pastoral care through Form Teacher periods. Briefings were arranged for Form Teachers on the use of available resources and feedback was collected through various means including interviews and Google Form. Representatives from the Team also attended Form Committee meetings to directly obtain feedback from Form Teachers and listen to their concerns.

To better look after students with special educational needs, case conferences were held for these students at the beginning of the school year. Individual plans were formulated as necessary and implementation strategies discussed with teachers concerned.

Student Development

During the school year, teachers-in-charge of student activities were given opportunities to attend Round Square events to enrich themselves with new ideas in supporting student development in their respective areas. One teacher attended the Round Square International Conference held in Montreal, Canada, to explore the Round Square Discovery Framework and to network with schools from over 50 countries. Besides, teachers of our Round Square Committee had meetings with representatives from two overseas Round Square schools and exchanged views and ideas on developing Round Square IDEALS.

A sharing session was held for the teacher advisers of academic societies related to science, mathematics and technology to exchange ideas on organising STEM-related activities. They shared about their challenges and discussed opportunities and ways to enhance students' engagement and participation through leadership training.

2. Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Development

To develop STEM education, teachers from Science, Mathematics, Computer and Design & Technology departments continued to collaborate closely to implement the STEM development plan. School-based curricula and learning environment were refined to promote STEM education in various forms with focus on junior forms. In addition, STEM-related extracurricular activities were arranged to arouse students' interest in STEM. Workshops were held on enrichment programme days for Form 1 to Form 3 students. For Form 1, students learned about the programming skills to control MBOT. For Form 2, students participated in Micro:bit, AppInventor and coding workshops. Form 3 students joined the "Engineer in School" programme organised by the China Light & Power Limited and attended a "One School One Engineer" talk. To further stretch the potential of students,

a STEM-related module will be introduced to the ACE (Aesthetic and Creativity Education) programme for Form 2 students in the coming academic year.

With teachers' support and guidance, our students participated in various external STEM related competitions and programmes and achieved outstanding results. Our students was awarded the 喬戈里峰獎 in the 1st International Artificial Intelligence Fair and was the Champion in CUHK Engineering SenseTime AI Competition 2019 for Secondary Schools. A team of Form 4 students was the champion at the Hong Kong Product Design Makeathon 2018-19. One student received a Bronze medal in the Hong Kong Olympiad in Informatics 2018-19. A Form 5 student represented Hong Kong and won a Silver medal in the 30th Biology Olympiad in Hungary. Another Form 5 student represented Hong Kong and won a silver medal in the 50th International Physics Olympiad 2019.

One team of students built a Rube Goldberg machine and received Honourable Mention in the Hong Kong GreenMech Contest 2019. Our Form 4 students won an Outstanding Award and a Meritorious Award in the International Mathematical Modelling Challenge.

To further promote STEM education among students, a STEM week was held from 8 to 12 April 2019. Mr Chan Yik Hei was invited to share his experiences as a young entrepreneur at morning assembly. Various game stalls and workshops were arranged by the Science, Mathematics, Computer and D&T clubs. Outstanding student works in various STEM-related activities were displayed on the campus. On-site STEM training courses such as VR+Unity, Micro:bit x Tinker Kit and Python were organised and students showed enthusiasm and support. Teachers also attended courses, talks or workshops related to STEM education and shared their experiences, useful resources and good practice. Useful resources on STEM-related programmes were uploaded to the school server for sharing between departments. Interfacing session with the Primary School was conducted on the development of STEM education.

3. *Sustainability and development of International Connections and the Chong Yau Pak Wan Residence Hall*

The College obtained permission from the Education Bureau to admit local long term boarders into the dormitory in 2019-2020. More opportunities for international exchanges with schools in other parts of the world continued to be on our agenda. In 2018-2019, besides hosting annual exchange programmes with our sister schools, we continued to host exchanges with Anglo-Chinese School (Independent) in Singapore where our students forged close relationships with their counterparts from Singapore. In return, 6 of our Form 4 students spent 5 days at Anglo-Chinese School (Independent) and experienced Boarding School life in Singapore.

Further to the above exchange opportunities, our students continued to participate actively in the Round Square International Conference that was held in October 2018 in Montreal, Canada, where they met and learned from their global peers and participated in a variety of activities that centred on the six pillars, IDEALS, of Round Square.

Spiritual and Moral Education

As a Christian college, we place a strong emphasis on nurturing the spiritual growth of our students. Through daily morning assemblies, Religious Studies lessons and Christian Fellowship programmes, the practice of Christian education is enhanced. This year, The Rev Vincent Chan and The Very Rev Matthias Der officiated at our Advent and Lent Services respectively. At these services, a total of \$14787.5 was collected and donated to 12 local voluntary organisations, including HKSKH Welfare Council Limited, St John's Cathedral and St James' Settlement. To show our love and care to the underprivileged in our society, we have also collected 50 gift bags which were donated to the underprivileged South Asian children in Tseung Kwan O through the Tseung Kwan O Integral South Asian Development Group. Teachers and students visited the children and held a Christmas party with them during Christmas.

At Christmas, the College followed the tradition of holding our Carol Service at St John's Cathedral (for Form 2 to Form 6 students) and at St Paul's Church (for Form 1 students), with The Rev Kenneth Lau and The Rev Amos Poon delivering the sermon respectively; while on Ascension Day, the service was held at St John's Cathedral with The Rev Canon Dr. Thomas Pang delivering the sermon.

Every Wednesday at morning assembly, we were grateful to our Chaplains from St John's Cathedral and St Paul's Church, The Very Rev Matthias Der, The Rev Canon Dr Thomas Pang, The Rev Vincent Chan, The Rev Wu Wai Ho and The Rev Jason Leung for coming regularly to give sermons to us. Besides, we were particularly excited to have members from our big SPCC family, including Christian alumni and parents, to share their faith and life experience with us at the morning assembly. We also invited Miss Dorothy Chan, Miss Lorraine Chiang, Miss Esther Tang, Mr Geoffrey Ko and Mr Kan Tat Keung to share at morning assembly. Students were impressed by their testimonies and their faithful service in different sectors of the society.

This year, the theme of the Christian Fellowship was 與主同行, "Walk With Him". In our life, we always face different adversities that may knock us down. However, when we choose to follow Jesus and walk with God, we believe that God will prepare the best for us. We hope that all the participants can get to know more about God's guidance in our daily lives and lead a life full of joy. Through regular gatherings, morning prayer meetings and cell group sharing, students were nurtured in Christian faith. In addition, TueStation, a religious luncheon gathering for junior form students, with the Christian parents (prayer group of PTA) providing food and the teachers giving Biblical sharing served over a hundred students. All these activities provided our students with a supportive environment for spiritual growth.

The Religious Week was held from 4 to 22 December 2018, a music worship and evangelical rally was held at morning assembly and we have invited The Very Rev Samson Fan to share God's message with our students. Activities like Love Action, handicraft workshop, gospel gathering at Tuestation, and Carol Singing and game booth were held to arouse students' interest in Christianity.

The Moral cum Civic Education and Pastoral Care Team organised various activities during the year. All Form 1 students participated in the School Transition and Attributes Development Programme to familiarise themselves with the SPCC Student Profile. ICAC, Department of Health, The Family Planning Association, The Hong Kong Federation of Youth and St James' Settlement were invited to give talks and hold workshops for students on various topics such as mental health, anti-corruption, positive self-image, cyber citizenship and sex education. In addition, a series of materials under the framework of Positive Education were designed for Form Teacher Periods.

Apart from individual counselling, our three school social workers from St James' Settlement organised different developmental groups for students. Over 40 senior form students were coached through The Big Brother Big Sister Scheme to help the Form 1 students adapt to secondary school life. About 30 Form 1 and 30 Form 2 students joined the Play, Sharing, Practice (PSP) groups to enhance their coping skills and positive self-image. Activities included lunchtime gatherings and sharing, overnight camps and outdoor activities. Interpersonal relationship workshops were conducted for Form 3 classes to guide students on the management of intimate relationships. A series of seven activities were also organised throughout the year as part of the Life Connection Programmes (LCP) with a total of more than 100 participants. A service trip to an orphanage in Sichuan was arranged in collaboration with Gratia during the Easter holidays, with 29 students participating in the trip.

Leadership and Service Learning

During the Student Activities Week (SAW), Form 1 students enjoyed a safe and engaging adventure-based learning programme with Dragonfly. Form 2 students travelled to Nanjing for a historical and cultural exploration trip in association with the University of Hong Kong and Nanjing University. In Form 3, we completed a successful place-based education programme in Tai O, Yim Tin Tsai and Kuk Po in Hong Kong. Form 4 students were engaged in a variety of service learning programmes with organisations such as Grace Centre, Methodist Epworth Village Community Centre and Hok Yau Club, etc. Some students had self-organised their service learning programmes with other service providers or charity organisations. Form 5 students were provided with options of a variety of business and university attachment programmes across a diverse range of sectors, including overseas service learning trips to Phuket and Laos. They had also self-initiated educational programmes in areas related to community service, work place attachment and individual study experiences at tertiary, etc.

All junior form students completed a one-day service learning programme between February and March. Form 1 students took part in beach cleaning activities across several locations around Hong Kong. Form 2 students spent the day with elderlies at St. Luke's Settlement Neighbourhood Elderly Centre, St. James' Settlement C&W District Elderly Community Centre, Fong Shu Chuen District Elderly Community Centre and Choi Hung Community Centre for Senior Citizens. Form 3 students spent the day on an integration programme with mild mentally disabled students at Saviour Lutheran School and Choi Jun School.

Leadership programmes were organized to meet the students' individual needs : the Thailand International Model United Nations (THAIMUN) 2019, the In-house Leadership Programmes for junior and senior students, the Prefects' Leadership Training Programme and overseas trips to various places such as the US, Australia, France, Korea, Singapore, South Africa and Mainland China.

Rites of Passage

This was the eleventh Rites of Passage programme and involved 201 Form 3 students spending 28 days in Queensland, Australia. Spread across three residential campuses, and through a variety of experiences focused around the four key components of outdoor activities, expeditions, enquiry based learning and community living, the students were challenged physically, mentally and emotionally. Through these challenges they learned more about themselves, others and the world around them.

Round Square

Round Square is a worldwide network of innovative schools in 40 countries across five continents that share a holistic philosophy in education. As a global member, our students and staff have opportunities to take part in regional and international conferences, service projects and exchanges with other Round Square schools.

A student committee within the school is tasked with developing and promoting activities that match the six IDEALS of Round Square: Internationalism, Democracy, Environmentalism, Adventure, Leadership and Service. With student ownership of Round Square activities within the school, we have high expectations for our future involvement throughout the region and globally.

Last year, we sent one teacher and five students to attend the Round Square International Conference 2018 in Montreal, Canada. Two speakers from the Zero Waste Life Hong Kong and the Lifelong Animal Protection Charity were invited to our morning assembly to talk about the ideals of Environmentalism and Service respectively. By working closely with the Student Union and the Environmental Protection Club, our Round Square Student Committee organised our charity Green Fashion Show featuring both teacher and student models. The Green Fashion Show raised over \$8000 to aid the Round Square Discovery Fund, which supports the engagement of students in international service projects such as building vital infrastructure in impoverished rural communities.

Language and Culture

Foreign Language Studies

In 2018-2019, we offered two streams of foreign language studies to students: Programme A for interest and Programme B for academic pursuit.

For Programme A, we had two German/Arabic Hors d'oeuvre classes on Fridays after school. They exposed students to the German and Arabic cultures through learning the basics of the languages.

For Programme B, we offered Foundation Spanish and Foundation French Levels 1-4 and DSE/CIE Spanish (F6) classes on weekdays and Saturdays. The purpose was to build up students' foundation in the two languages; thus, paving the way for foreign language studies in senior secondary and university.

Eight students took the IGCSE Spanish Exams in May 2019 and achieved brilliant results. Two of them achieved the highest level of 9 and another two reached level 8.

Among the eight students who took the IGCSE French Exams, two of them achieved level 8 and four reached level 7.

As for DSE/CIE Spanish, three F6 students took the exam in October 2018. All of them got A in the written papers. One of them achieved Distinction in Speaking while the other two obtained Merit.

Culture Salon Activities

The theme for 2018-2019 was *Cultural Perspectives of Secondary Students* 中學生的文化眼界.

Various activities were organised to expose students to different cultural aspects through language fun event, assembly presentations and talks, cultural walk, visits and exhibitions. To give students a taste of the German and Arabic languages and cultures, we co-organised a German/Arabic Fun event with Ms Leila, the Arabic teacher, and the School of Modern Languages & Cultures of the University of Hong Kong on 22 February 2019. The Event commenced with an introduction of some fun facts about Germany such as its history, cultural festivals, scenery and signature dishes. The highlight of the event was the refreshment break with typical German and Arabic beverages and delicacies. In the last session, after presenting traditional costumes and music, the Arabic teacher gave a drum and dance performance to wrap up the programme on a lively note.

Enthusiasts Circles (同好小組) met irregularly for sharing among like-minded students who had similar interests in different aspects. In the past year, their interests included Psychology, Wikipedia, Korean culture and French language & culture.

Aesthetics and Creativity

Exhibition and Assembly Talk

Mr Richard Kan, alumnus and donor of Zhuyuetang Exhibition Gallery, held an exhibition “A Millennium of Monochromes from the Great Tang to the High Qing” from November 2018 to January 2019. The exhibition showcased the photographs of his Chinese monochrome porcelain collection. The pictures of his collection had been exhibited at Switzerland’s Baur Foundation, Museum of Far Eastern Art. Mr Kan gave the students a talk about the historic, artistic and technical features of the monochrome porcelains at morning assembly. He also donated a book ‘A Millennium of Monochromes’ to the school library. To show our gratitude, a student created a painting which depicted the name of the exhibition gallery, Zhuyuetang (竹月堂) and presented it to Mr Kan.

An alumna, Ms Alice Chan was invited to hold her solo art exhibition ‘Flower, Power, The Natural Awakening, + Resilience of Mother Nature’ in the Zhuyuetang Exhibition Gallery from November 2018 to March 2019. Apart from the exhibition, Ms Chan shared with our students about her art exploring experience at morning assembly. She also conducted a lunchtime workshop to teach the basic painting techniques. All the paintings created in the workshop were displayed together with Ms Chan’s exhibits in the Gallery.

Artist-in-Residence Programme

In collaboration with the Language and Culture Working Group, the third Artist-in-Residence Programme was held from March to May 2019. The guest artist, a Hong Kong film maker, Mr Bill McQueen, was invited to deliver 4 workshops to 17 students to teach the basic skills of script writing, directing, acting, interviewing, filming and editing. Meanwhile, 12 winning films from “Across Asia Youth Film Festival 2018” were showed during lunchtime to enrich students’ vision in the realm of filming world. In the final session of the workshop, students were divided into groups to create short films. All the products were showed in the Lecture Theatre on 17 May. One of the films “茶心茗香” will be submitted to participate in the coming “Across Asia Youths Film Festival”.

The Odyssey of the Mind Programme 2019

Seven Form 4 students took part in the Odyssey of the Mind (OM) Hong Kong Regional Tournament on 2 March 2019. With the support of teachers and parents, the team won the overall champion in the division and was invited to participate in the World Finals. This was the sixth time for our school to represent Hong Kong to compete with the world teams in the World Finals.

The OM World Finals was held from 22 to 25 May in Michigan State University in the US. Taking part in the World Finals was a fruitful experience for our students. Visiting the Michigan State Capitol, trading pins, sharing and learning about different cultures, all these unforgettable experiences had broadened students' horizons.

Competitions

A Form 3 girl won the 2nd runner-up in 中環半山扶手電梯「連繫·社區·文化」繪畫比賽 and gained the opportunity to display her artwork in the public area nearby the Central-Mid-Levels Escalator and in the H6 Conet for two weeks. Two girls from Form 1 and Form 2 were awarded the Merit Prize in the Healthy Net Comic Drawing Competition–Net Addiction. A Form 2 boy won the honourable mention in 第五屆紫荊盃兩岸暨港澳青少年書畫大賽 – 中學國畫組. A Form 4 girl was among the top ten senior finalists in the Wool4School Design Competition and obtained a place to join a special workshop arranged by the organisation. A Form 2 girl got into the finals of the Generation I Multimedia Competition-Comic Illustration and was invited to attend a workshop conducted by the caricaturist Dreamergo.

Other activities

A Form 2 boy was nominated to participate in “Art Buddies 2019”. Two students from Form 4 and 5 were nominated to join the “11th Art Ambassador in School Scheme”. Through these activities, the Hong Kong Arts Development Council had facilitated a good platform for our students to showcase their creativity.

On 25 June 2019, twenty-one students, including members from the Stage Management Society, joined a guided tour of the School of Theatre and Entertainment Arts Graduate Exhibition 2019 at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts and attended a Lighting Design Workshop.

Extra-Curricular Activities and Enrichment Programmes

Student-organised extra-curricular activities have always been an important component of students' education. These activities not only allow students to join programmes of their own choice, but also enable them to learn about leadership and teamwork, as well as undergo gratifying and rewarding experiences. A list of extra-curricular activities offered is given in **Table 1**.

Our school came first for the BOCHK Bauhinia Bowl Award under the Co-educational category for 2018-2019. The award is regarded as one of the most prestigious Sports awards in Hong Kong. Thanks to all sports team members, coaches, and teachers who had devoted much of their time in training to achieve such a significant performance in all sports.

Our Swimming Gala was held on 6 December 2018 at Victoria Park Swimming Pool with Mr Andrew Luk, Chairman of SPCCAA as the guest of honour for the prize presentation. Our annual Sports Day was held on 15 April 2019 at Tsing Yi Sports Ground with Mr Fok Kai Kong Kenneth, Vice President

of Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China as the guest of honour to present the prizes.

Form 1 students were introduced to track and field events on the Athletics Activities Day on 15 January 2019. Form 3 and Form 2 students had the opportunity to try out various sports on 27 March 2019 and 30 April 2019 respectively. These sports included tenpin bowling, lawn bowls, archery, hockey, golf, sports climbing and Lacrosse/shuttlecock.

To allow students to make better use of their summer vacation, a Summer Sports Training Programme was arranged for all students. This year's activities included fencing, swimming, dance (hip hop), and table tennis. Intensive training was provided for members of the school teams, including basketball, badminton, volleyball, fencing, soccer, swimming and table tennis.

In the field of music, the College continues its long-standing tradition in cultivating a passion for and appreciation of this art form among all our students. Over 400 students were engaged in one or more of the many after-school musical activities on offer, ranging from choirs to orchestras, band to ensembles. Collectively, they worked tirelessly to strive for their own lofty artistic aspirations. As a part of their yearly programme, the various music teams competed in various local and international competitions. Among the many prizes and awards garnered, the Treble Choir won four major awards including the Overall Champion in the 14th International Busan Choral Festival and Competition, as well as 5 first prizes, 1 first runner-up and 5 second runners-up in the 71st Hong Kong Schools Music Festival.

On PMG's 10th Anniversary, students from the Programme for the Musically Gifted of the College were invited by the Hong Kong Economic Trade Office of Chengdu to perform on national television in the capital of Sichuan in January 2019. In May, students from the College together with a few of their peers performed the entire Beethoven 7th Symphony without a conductor alongside 12 members of the London Mozart Players at the International Music Conference 2019. The academic year came to a resounding close when all music teams gathered together in sharing their music in the Summer Concert – titled "*Coffee or Tea*" – on 3 July 2019 in the Hong Kong City Hall Concert Hall.

Enrichment programmes for all forms were organised three times in the year to further enrich students' knowledge and experiences in different areas. Activities included talks and workshops by professionals and renowned personnel related to moral and civic education, culture, STEM education, entrepreneurship education and career planning. Outings and field trips were also organised by teachers.

Student Union

Being a fully elected student body, the Student Union (SU) always upholds its commitment to the school community. Through the in-school and joint-school activities held throughout the year, the SU aims to create a flourished and diverse student life which enhances students' sense of belonging to the SPCC family.

During this school year, the SU organized a variety of events including the Teacher-Student Carnival, talent shows and other festive celebrations. The theme of this year's Opinion Programme was to investigate students' sense of belonging to SPCC and the entire student body was actively involved in discussion. The survey shed light on the future direction of developing schoolmates' unity in the SPCC family, for example, through further enhancing the current cheerleading atmosphere at SPCC. In addition, the Student Union continued to work closely with the Environmental Protection Club and the

Round Square Student Committee to launch our charity Green Fashion Show and raised over \$8000 to donate to the Round Square Discovery Fund.

The SU placed great emphasis on the leadership training programme, hoping to inspire and empower the youth community. The annual overnight training camp was held at the dormitory for its committee members and class representative committee members. Through regular gatherings and activities, the SU aspired to instill into youngsters a sense of leadership and responsibility. In July, the SU cooperated with many school clubs and societies in organising the Games Day, which brought the exciting year to an end.

Achievements of Students

Public Examination Results

Building on the tradition of academic excellence at SPCC, both our Form 6 DSE and IB students achieved admirable results in their respective public examinations. These results reflected our students' diligence, passion for learning and pursuit of excellence. Our best achievers in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE) Examination included a perfect scorer who attained the highest achievable result of level 5** in 7 subjects as well as the Mathematics Extended Part, and two students who attained level 5** in 6 subjects. Our IB cohort achieved equally impressive results with two perfect scorers attaining 45 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) Examination.

Achievements in Extra-curricular Activities

It was most gratifying to see many of our students winning awards and excelling in various inter-school competitions. We wish to congratulate the winners as well as all who have participated in and provided support for these competitions. Enhancement of teacher professional development and personal wellness

On 18 October 2018, we organised a Macau Education Tour for teachers to exchange professional knowledge and views with their counterparts at SKH Choi Kou School Macau. We also toured some of the UNESCO Heritage sites in Macau.

On 26 November 2018, we arranged a talk on Practical Legal Knowledge for Teachers. Legal issues in educational practice were covered including sexual harassment, failure to supervise and duty of care, etc. and real cases were studied.

Our primary and secondary school teachers participated in a solemn and peaceful retreat in St Paul's Church on 4 January 2019. Rev Amos Poon officiated the service and Bishop Andrew Chan illustrated the relationship between our school and the church.

On 14 January 2019, teachers were divided into groups to examine our major strengths and areas for improvement concerning school development, teacher professional development needs and support for student development. They also reviewed our development priorities and the effectiveness of major tasks conducted in order to refine the school development plan for the next school development cycle.

To encourage teachers to live a healthy lifestyle, physical activities were arranged for the Staff Development Day on 4 April 2019. Teachers could engage in different physical exercises including fitness training, badminton, yoga, basketball, table-tennis and hiking.

A workshop on Positive Education was conducted on 29 May 2019 for teachers to have a better understanding of character strengths and its application in our daily lives. Teachers were provided the opportunity to share among ourselves and also to identify areas for further development using the Growth Mindset.

Involvement of Parents and Alumni

Parents have always played an indispensable role in the holistic education for children. We are pleased to see staunch support from our parents again this year. A range of activities were organised by the Parent-Teacher Association during the year. Please refer to **Table 3** for details.

Our wholehearted gratitude goes to our alumni for their enthusiastic support and contribution to the development of the College. The Alumni Association has been growing from strength to strength, helping to foster the bonding among our graduates over the decades. **Table 4** is a summary of their activities last year.
