Upholding the values of "Faith, Hope, and Love," SPCC remains dedicated to nurturing young people who are grounded in character, guided by compassion, and equipped with a strong sense of social responsibility.

Values education is central to the holistic development of our students. Guided by our development plan, the College has long prioritised whole-person education and the balanced development of mind, body, and spirit. In recent years, we have established a school-based framework encompassing twelve core values, integrating a positive ethos intentionally across academic learning, co-curricular programmes, and student life. These include extra-curricular activities, life-long learning, Enrichment Programme Days, Student Activities Week (SAW), and the Rites of Passage (RoP) programme. Through whole-school participation and cross-disciplinary collaboration, students are engaged in rich learning experiences that nurture their aspirations, broaden their global perspectives, and prepare them to become confident and responsible leaders of tomorrow.



As young people navigate the complexities and challenges of modern life, the College remains deeply committed to supporting their well-being alongside academic excellence. Wellness has been purposefully embedded within our values education, with a focus on emotional awareness, positive thinking, and self-understanding. We encourage students to recognise and manage their emotions, cultivate empathy, build healthy relationships, and develop self-confidence, thereby strengthening their resilience and inner well-being.



Developing 21st-Century Competencies Through Global Learning Experiences

In the 21st century, learning is not only confined to the classroom. We prepare our students for a complex world by fostering in them the concept of internationalism, a mindset that transcends geography and embraces a shared responsibility for our global community. To achieve this, we encourage students to develop their adaptability while honing their communication and collaboration skills. As a member school of Round Square, a worldwide network of innovative schools in 50 countries across six continents that share a holistic philosophy of education, our students have opportunities to take part in regional and international conferences, service projects and exchange programmes that promote the six IDEALS of Round Square:





Internationalism, Democracy, Environmentalism, Adventure, Leadership and Service. Moreover, through a diverse range of school-organised overseas service-learning programmes, as well as self-organised initiatives, our students gain exposure to various cultures, broaden their global perspectives, and develop a strong sense of social responsibility.

Strengthening Teachers Capacity for Inclusive, Innovative, and Future-Ready Education

Regarding staff development, we aim to empower teachers with the aptitude, skills and knowledge needed to navigate new challenges brought about by emerging trends. The College regularly distributes practical resources and professional development materials through various platforms to strengthen our teachers' ability to support students' holistic development. Teachers are also nominated for specialised training sessions offered by the Education Bureau and other leading institutions, equipping them with strategies for



inclusive education. Furthermore, teachers engage in diverse well-being initiatives and team-building activities during professional development days. These initiatives enhance their wellness by fostering collaboration, reducing stress, and building a supportive professional network.

In addition, the College continues to enhance students' digital competencies through a comprehensive and forward-looking approach. Information technology, programming, STEM education, artificial intelligence applications, and information literacy are thoughtfully incorporated into our teaching and learning. Continuous investment in digital infrastructure and campus networks further enables students to harness technology effectively for learning, communication, and innovation.



In alignment with the College's development plan, we will continue to refine our curricular and co-curricular programmes, strengthen partnerships with professional organisations, and invest in teacher development. 育德創新，幸福同行

在瞬息萬變的二十一世紀，教育不僅是知識的傳遞，更是學生品格的塑造與潛能的啟迪。學校秉承信、望、愛的校訓和前瞻性的教育理念，致力於為學生建構一個接軌未來、充滿關愛的成長平台。

1. 價值導航，素質紮根： 構建全校培育模式的價值觀教育

學校教育的核心始於對人格特質的塑造。我們以「聖保羅九大學生素質」為基石，於2020年確立了十二個核心價值觀。這套體系緊扣教育局價值觀教育的培育目標，結合聖公會教省的教育宗旨，並注入中華文化元素，形成具備國際視野與文化自信的培育框架。自2021年度起，價值觀教育正式納入學校發展的重中之重。我們採取「全校參與」模式，以成長課與宗教科為雙主軸，將核心價值觀有機滲透至各學習領域。透過週會、早禱的主題分享、級本培育活動及多元服務實踐，全校師生秉持「同一顆心、同一目標、同一行動、同一準則」的理念共同努力。此外，我們深信家校合作是成功的關鍵，藉2023年度起推行之「校本家長教育課程」(SPPEP) 賦能家長，與學校攜手成為學生的成長同行者。透過凝聚多方能量，我們培育學生建立正向價值觀，強化國民身份認同，使其未來能積極貢獻國家，成為推動和諧發展的棟樑。

2. 知行合一，探究創新： 打造接軌未來的學習平台

在課程發展方面，我們秉承「從課堂走向未來」的信念，建構縱向銜接與橫向整合的立體架構。在人文與語言領域，課程強調「知行合一」，將文學賞析與價值引導深度融合，在提升語言能力的同時，厚植學生的家國情懷。邏輯與科學範疇則全面貫徹「探究—實踐—創新」模式。我們不單強化螺旋式知識建構，更透過建模思維與工程設計，提升學生解決複雜問題的高階思維。配合先進的硬體設施，學校將電子學習由單純的技術應用，提升至資訊素養與數字公民教育層次。其中最具特色的校本跨學科綜合課程 MASTER 2.0，成功打破學科壁壘，系統性地培育學生的共通能力。從基礎學養到前瞻素養，我們的課程不僅賦予學生知識，更致力於重塑其思維模式，裝備他們自信地面對未來挑戰。

3. 多元啟迪，愛連世界： 全人發展與交流共成長

我們深信，課室之外存在著更廣闊的學習空間。學校將多元課外活動視為啟迪學生潛能的核心路徑，廣泛開設體育、藝術、語文、創科等課外活動，並引入人工智能等項目，確保學生與時代脈搏同步。校內23個比賽團隊透過嚴謹訓練，磨練學生的責任感與堅毅精神。無論是在本地賽事還是國際舞台，參賽的過程皆是「愛己愛人」精神的實踐。近年，我們積極拓展與內地姊妹學校的情誼，透過小六畢業國內交流團、大灣區交流活動與文化藝術考察等，打破學習空間的限制。無論是音樂團隊在國際舞台上的文化演繹，還是體育校隊和內地精英運動員的球技切磋，學生在交流中學會互助欣賞與彼此尊重。未來，我們將持續提供更多國際交流機會，擴闊學生的全球視野，引導他們在實踐中豐富學習體驗。

4. 擁抱變革，成就卓越： 以幸福感驅動校園轉型

「幸福感」是學校教育實踐的基石。德育及牧養組將PERMA+H幸福元素與性格強項植入培育架構，啟發學生自我欣賞和潛能發揮。2025學年學校更成立「Well-being 小組」，專責統籌全校的幸福規劃。在教與學層面，我們優化評估政策，減少總結性評估的次數，並推動多元化的進展性學習評估，旨在減輕學生壓力，回歸身心健康的教育本質。與此同時，我們同樣重視教師的幸福與專業成長。學校致力營造關懷互助的工作環境，推動關注身心靈健康的老師活動。除了專業培訓，我們更帶領教師境外考察，接軌國際教育前沿。我們深知：「要培養應對挑戰的學生，必先有願意擁抱變革的教師。」透過鼓勵教師勇於嘗試與創新，師生在共學中建立幸福感，共同成就卓越的教育品質。

未來，我們將持續深耕這片教育沃土，以正向價值觀教育領航，深化跨領域超學科的自主學習模式(Transdisciplinary Learning)，豐富文化交流體驗，並推展健康身心靈生活，讓每一位聖保羅學子都能在基督的愛滋養下，茁壯成長，勇敢邁向未來。
